





Preparation of the Altar





In processing to receive Eucharist please approach single file, exiting the stalls toward the back of the Chapel. As you do, maintain physical distance of 3 feet between yourself and the person in front of you. Everyone must receive on the hand (not on the tongue). Step aside, and consume the host without completely removing your mask. Return to your place, <u>via the side aisles</u>, maintaining the required physical distance.

If possible, please sanitize your hands before receiving Holy Communion.
